Accessible Bus for individuals with multiple disabilities is first of its kind. Sponsored by HPCL under its CSR initiative this highly accessible bus costing 24.00 lakhs will have facility for special seating of 39 number of Divyangjans and 4 number of wheelchair bound Divyangjans. This bus will soon serve as a model of best practice with the potential of revolutionizing the concept of public-transport system for making it accessible.

The CPCL Chennai *(Chennai Petroleum Corporation Limited)* under their CSR initiative has accepted to build an Accessible Special Utility Area for our beneficiaries and parents in NIEPMD at the cost of 31.70 lakhs. Hundreds of beneficiaries and parents those come to NIEPMD for various services will greatly benefit from this facility. This area will have a Waiting Area, a Dining Area, a Canteen, Feeding Area, Resting Area and Toilets.
