Qualifying Criteria

There will be internal and external examinations for both theory and practical. Internal

examinations (Both theory and practical) will be conducted at the end of 2nd & 4th month for 200

marks. Final examinations (Both theory and practical) will be conducted at the end of the six

month for 200 marks. The theory examination will be a combination of fill in the blanks,

matching, true or false, short answer and essay type in nature. For practical examination practical

book record, case presentation, management of Basic Activities/Emergencies will be evaluated.

Passing marks for theory 40% and practical 50% respectively. Students are required to pass in

theory and practical individually. In the event of the candidate failing in the final examination,

he/she can avail chances for supplementary examinations as per scheme of examinations.
