**Eligibility:**

1. Applicant age should be minimum 18 years at the time of applying for the training.
2. The applicant must be:
  - Minimum 8<sup>th</sup> standard pass or equivalent and should have completed the primary training/RCI Primary training course.

**OR**

- The applicant must be minimum 10<sup>th</sup> standard pass or equivalent.

**Admission Criteria:**

Candidates will be selected as per the norms and guidelines of the National Trust.

**Programme Content & Credits:**

This course will have basic module with study duration of 6 months covering areas such as health, nutrition, basic care giving for the persons with Intellectual Disability, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Cerebral Palsy and Multiple Disabilities.

**Attendance Requirement:**

Minimum 80% attendance is required to appear for the final Examinations.

**Qualifying Criteria :**

There will be internal and external examinations for both theory and practical. Internal examinations (Both theory and practical) will be conducted at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> month for 200 marks. Final examinations (Both theory and practical) will be conducted at the end of the six month for 200 marks. The theory examination will be a combination of fill in the blanks, matching, true or false, short answer and essay type in nature. For practical examination practical book record, case presentation, management of Basic Activities/Emergencies will be evaluated. Passing marks for theory 40% and practical 50% respectively. Students are required to pass in theory and practical individually. In the event of the candidate failing in the final examination, he/she can avail chances for supplementary examinations as per scheme of examinations.
