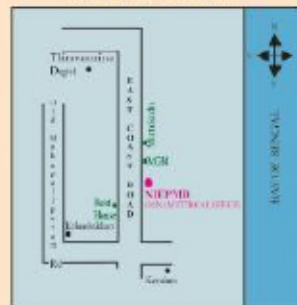

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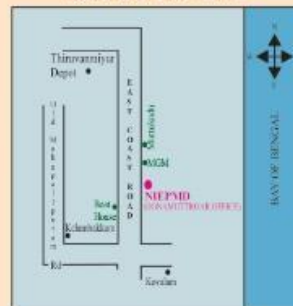
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ABOUT NIEPMD

National Institute of Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (Divyangjan) (NIEPMD) was established in 2005, at East coast Road, Muttukadu, Kovalam post, Tamilnadu (about 30 km from Chennai central Railway station, Mofussil Bus terminus and airport) under the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) Govt. of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, with an objective to serve as a national resource centre for the Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (Divyangjan) such as those with two or more disabilities in a person.

Multiple Disability means more than one of the following disabilities such as Blindness, Low-Vision, Leprosy cured Persons, Hearing Impairment (deaf & hard of hearing),



Locomotor Disability, Dwarfism, Intellectual Disability, Mental Illness, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Cerebral Palsy, Muscular Dystrophy, Chronic Neurological Condition, Specific Learning Disabilities, Multiple Sclerosis, Speech & Language disability, Thalassemia, Hemophilia, Sickle cell disease, Acid attack victim, Parkinson's Diseases and Multiple Disabilities including deaf blindness. A condition in which a person may have combination of hearing & Visual impairment causing severe communication, development & educational problems.

According to the definition and adhering the RPwD Act 2016 any person suffering with a condition of any two or more out of 21 disabilities specified in the act are entitled to avail the services.

- To promote and conduct research in all areas relating to Multiple Disabilities (Divyangjan).
