These vital thought of Mrs Gomathi was fully supported by the family members and now the family of Karan & Ezilarasi is busily preparing Phenoyl, Soap powder, organic napkins, Jute bags, wire bags, organic saambrani, Hay greeting card etc

The family thus grown as a role model in supportive employment now comfortably marketing their products under the regular guidance of DAIL and also gladly honoured by the Goi with a National Award recently.
