National Institute for Empowerment of persons with Multiple Disabilities (NIEPMD) is established by the Govt of India, under the administrative control of Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment at ECR, Muttukadu Chennai in the Year 2005. The Institute is first of its kind in the Country set up by the Central Govt. to serve as a national resource centre for catering holistic rehabilitation services of persons having more than one disability as per PwD Act, 1995 and National Trust Act, 1999.

Section 4:

Description and Definitions of success indicators and proposed measurement methodology:

1. Human Resource Development:-

- (a) Long Term training programme are those conducted for a minimum of one academic year as approved by RCI and/or the Executive Council.
 - Measurement: Results declared at the end of the year by the appropriate authorities.
- (b) Short Term training programs are those of six months and lesser duration. They are aimed at capacity building of parents and/or rehabilitation professionals
 - Measurement: Records maintained by the Institute.

2. Services & Programmes:-

The Institute undertakes assessment and evaluation covering case history taking, physical and medical examination, intellectual and developmental assessment, special educational assessment, therapeutic needs assessment, and vocational assessment. Neurological screening and examination is also being carried in consultation with the Government General Hospital, Chennai. Need based intervention programs are developed to provide training for persons with Multiple Disabilities at various sittings.

The number of persons with single disabilities is more and achievement in their rehabilitation is relatively easier .As a matter of policy decision (zero rejection) NIEPMD is providing services to persons with single disability. Hence the number of persons with single disabilities registered is almost twice the number of registered cases with multiple disabilities. Measurement: From the statistics of Registration & Records section of the Institute.

3. Awareness & Information Services and Implementation of ADIP Scheme:

The Institute is also focusing on **Awareness and Information Services** through its dedicated disabled friendly Website, mass media coverage on the activities of the institute, disseminating information on the services provided by the Institute through print and electronic media, display of awareness posters and advertisements, distribution of awareness materials to the field workers, conduct of awareness camps on prevention, early intervention/detection etc.,

Scheme of Assistance to Disabled persons for purchase/fitting of Aids/Appliances (ADIP) Services

This scheme was introduced since inception of the institute to supply Aids and Appliances to the persons with disabilities. The main objective of the Scheme is to assist the needy disabled persons in procuring durable, sophisticated and scientifically manufactured, modern, standard aids and appliances that can promote their physical, social and psychological rehabilitation, by reducing the effects of disabilities and enhance their economic potential. The aids and appliances supplied under the scheme shall confirm to Bureau of Indian Standard (BIS) specifications to the extent possible. Assessment and Distribution camps were organized as per the need and requirement of the community

Measurement: From the statistics and records available with the Institute.

4. Research & Development:

Research Projects are approved by the Academic Committee and supervised by the Ethics Committee. Efforts have been taken to attract technical and financial support from external agencies and to have collaborative R& D activities in the field of Multiple Disabilities. At present three research programmes are ongoing.

Publications include research articles published in peer reviewed indexed journals and books.

Paper presentations are research works that have been selected for platform/poster presentation by the faculties of the Institute at related professional conferences, technical workshops, seminars etc.

<u>Measurement:</u> From the records of approved projects by the academic committee; Number accepted by the respective Universities / Professional bodies;

Off Prints/copies of published books and journals; and the numbers accepted by the conference secretariat as communicated to the Institute.
