## **Instruction Regarding the Entrance Examination**

- a) The candidates must report by 09.00 am at NIEPMD(D). The 'cut off time' for reporting to the exam centre will be 10.00 am. Candidates reporting after the cut off time will not be allowed for the written examination.
- b) Candidates will **not** be allowed to enter the examination hall without the Admit Card and ID Proof under any circumstances.
- c) Candidates must hold any one of the original Government authorised photo identity proof (like Aadhaar Card, Driving License, Passport, Voter Id Card, etc.) of their identity and also a recent passport size photo (as submitted in the application form) **Note:** E-copy of the ID proof will not be considered.
- d) Candidates must keep a photocopy of the Admit Card for future references, as the original admit card will be collected at the examination hall
- e) Candidates are **NOT PERMITTED** to have mobile phone(s) or any kind of electronic gadgets, including smart watches, scanning devices and any papers, notes, books, calculators, etc., inside the examination hall.
- f) Possession of any unauthorized material including those mentioned above or indulging in copying or impersonation or adopting unfair means, will lead to disqualification of candidature.
- g) Candidate should use only blue / black ball point pen to write/fill, his/her particulars on TEST BOOKLET/OMR SHEET. Use of PENCIL / WHITE FLUID and OVER WRITING / CUTTING on TEST BOOKLET and OMR SHEET is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- h) On completion of the examination, the candidate must handover the OMR SHEET along with the TEST BOOKLET and the ADMIT CARD to the invigilator in the exam hall.
- i) NIEPMD will **NOT** be responsible for the safety of any valuables / possessions carried by the candidates at the examination centre.
- j) The announcement of the shortlisted candidates of the written examination will be uploaded in the Institute's website <a href="https://niepmd.tn.nic.in">https://niepmd.tn.nic.in</a>. No personal intimation will be sent to the candidates.
- k) Only the shortlisted candidates will be called for the interview. The details regarding the same will be given on the day of announcement of the results.
- 1) The candidature of the candidates for admissions is provisional and is subject to candidate fulfilling the conditions as specified in the eligibility criteria of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai. If any discrepancy is found, the candidature of the candidate is liable to be cancelled at any stage of their admission procedure or even after the final admission.
