### 7. Conference

National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (Divyanjan) (NIEPMD) in association with National Commission for Protection of Child Rights(NCPCR), New Delhi organized the conference on "Beyond Medical Diagnosis: Integration of Psychosocial Perspectives on Rehabilitation and Reintegration of Child Sexual Abuse Victims" on 21<sup>st</sup> December 2019 at NIEPMD. Dr.R.G.Anand, Member, NCPCR, inaugurated the conference. This conference had enlightened and created awareness among the masses about the attributes of Child Sexual Abuse (CSA) for its role in

understanding the dynamics of its epidemiological rise in India.
